- Coaches: Reservations required.**
- Business class:** Ticket price includes non-alcoholic beverage and access to the Amtrak Metropolitan Lounge in Chicago.
- Sleeping cars:** Viewliner sleeping accommodations. Amtrak Metropolitan Lounge/ClubAcela available in New York, Philadelphia, Washington, DC and Chicago, for Sleeping car passengers.
- Dining:** Combined Diner/Lounge provides food and beverage service.
- Checked baggage at select stations.
- Wi-Fi available.
- Trainside checked bicycle service offered between staffed locations handling checked baggage. Customers will check in with the station agent, get a claim check/baggage tag for their bike, and hand up to a crew member inside the baggage car. Visit Amtrak.com/bikes for more information.
